

AUTUMN SHOW AWARDS

W R Killens Salver – for the most points in Rose Classes at the Summer and Autumn Shows.

Princess Diana Memorial Trophy – for the best exhibit in a class to be nominated in the TBHS newsletter.

Dahlia Trophy – for the best exhibit in the Dahlia classes at the Autumn Show.

Chrysanthemum Trophy – for the best exhibit in the Chrysanthemum classes at the Autumn Show.
(Presented by Messrs Mann, Crossman & Paulin)

Banksian Royal Horticultural Society Medal – for the winner of the most prize money in Horticultural classes in the year. Note that a repeat award cannot be made within 3 years.

Golden Jubilee Cup – for the most points obtained overall throughout the year. Note that a minimum of 5 points must be gained at each of the 3 shows.

Floral Art Trophy – for the most points obtained throughout the year in Floral Art.
(Presented by Miss H M Percy)

Bottone Shield – for the most points in Vegetable classes at the Summer and Autumn Shows.
(Presented by Mrs S Bottone)

Burley Trophy – for the most points obtained throughout the year in Homecraft classes.
(Presented by Mr And Mrs W Burley)

Diamond Trophy – for the best exhibit in the Homecraft classes at the Autumn Show.
(Presented by Hair & Son)

RHS Diplomas – may be presented for the best exhibit in each of the following classes:

Flowers, other than Dahlia and Chrysanthemum.
Floral Art
Fruit
Vegetables

FLOWERS

CHRYSANTHEMUMS

1. Three blooms, medium incurved, any variety or varieties.
2. Three blooms, medium reflexed, any variety or varieties.
3. One bloom, incurved or intermediate.
4. Vase of three sprays, one colour, with or without centre bud.

DAHLIAS

(Dahlias are classified as pom pom under 52mm, miniature under 115mm, small 115-170mm, medium 170-220mm, large 220-260mm, giant over 260mm).

5. Three blooms, medium decorative, any variety or varieties.
6. Three blooms, small decorative, any variety or varieties.
7. Three blooms, miniature decorative, any variety or varieties
8. Three blooms, medium cactus or semi-cactus, any variety or varieties.
9. Three blooms, small cactus or semi-cactus, any variety or varieties.
10. Three blooms, small ball, any variety or varieties.
11. Three blooms, miniature ball, any variety or varieties.
12. Five blooms, pom pom.
13. One bloom, decorative.
14. One bloom, cactus.
15. Bowl of dahlias, not more than 15 blooms, three or more varieties.
16. Three blooms, any other class including fimbriated.

ROSES

(Roses are classified below as Large Flowered (LF), Cluster Flowered (CF), or Dwarf Cluster (DC). (Classes 16 – 18, no buds allowed).

17. One bloom (LF), any variety.
18. Three blooms (LF), more than one variety.
19. Three blooms (LF), one variety.
20. Three stems (CF), any variety or varieties.
21. Bowl for frontal effect
22. Climbing or Rambling Rose, three stems.

OTHER FLOWERS AND PLANTS

23. Asters, single, five blooms, one or more varieties.
24. Asters, double, five blooms, one or more varieties.
25. Gladiolus, one spike.
26. Gladioli, three spikes, one or more varieties.
27. Michaelmas Daisies, one vase of five stems, any variety or varieties.
28. Pansies or violas, six blooms.
29. Shrubs, flowering or berried, container of one or more kinds.
30. Flowers, garden cut.
31. Vase of flowers, one variety.
32. Flowers raised from seed in twelve months preceding this show, three to twenty stems, one kind excluding Asters.
33. Begonia, pot grown, pots not exceeding 8 inches / 20cm.
34. Fuchsia, bush, pot grown.
35. Fuchsia, standard or half standard, pot grown.
36. Pot plant, foliage.
37. Zonal Pelargonium (Geranium) in pot not exceeding 10 inches / 25cm.
38. Gloxinia, pot not exceeding 8 inches / 20cm.
39. Fuchsias, six blooms, four varieties.
40. Bonsai.
41. Any other item of horticultural interest not covered in this section and only one entry. Any container should not exceed 12"/30cm.
42. Best flower stem from your garden

43. One orchid, pot grown

FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

44. Apples, four, dessert.
45. Apples, four, culinary.
46. Pears, four.
47. Plums, five.
48. Grapes, one bunch.
49. Twelve blackberries with stalks.
50. Dwarf French Beans, six pods.
51. Beans, runner, six pods.
52. Beet, round, three, one variety.
53. Cabbages, with 50mm of stalk, two.
54. Cauliflower, with 50mm of stalk, two.
55. Carrots, long pointed or stump rooted, three.
56. Cucumbers, ridge, two.
57. Cucumbers, indoor, two.
58. Culinary Herbs, selection of four kinds in a vase, from this selection -
 Basil, Bay, Chives, Lemon Balm, Mint, Parsley, Rosemary, Thyme.
59. Leeks, three.
60. Lettuces, cabbage, two with root.
61. Marrow, under 350mm in length, one.
62. Onions, three, one variety.
63. Onions, under 250grams, five, one variety.
64. Onions, grown from sets, five, one variety.
65. Parsnips, three.
66. Potatoes, coloured, round or kidney, five.
67. Potatoes, white, round or kidney, five.
68. Shallots, under 30mm dia, nine, one variety.
69. Shallots, large, six, one variety.
70. Tomatoes, approximately 65mm dia., five.

- 71. Cherry Tomatoes, under 35mm dia. seven.
- 72. Collection of vegetables, four kinds, numbers as for single classes, space 2 feet / 60cm square.
- 73. Mini-collection of vegetables, four kinds, one of each, space 2 feet / 60cm square.
- 74. Any other fruit or vegetables, not mentioned above. Only one entry.

FLORAL ART

(natural plant material must predominate)

- 75. Decorative display in teacup and saucer.
- 76. Arrangement in a shell.
- 77. Table decoration.
- 78. Floral napkin ring.
- 79. Basket of flowers.
- 80. Details in Newsletter.

JUNIOR GARDENER

(Under 16 years old. Please state age on entry).

- 81. Basket of flowers.
- 82. Anything handmade in the last six months.
- 83. Model made from vegetables.
- 84. Anything home grown.

MECRAFT

- 85. Jam, soft fruit, one glass jar.
- 86. Jam, stoned fruit, one glass jar.
- 87. Jelly Preserve.
- 88. Chutney
- 89. Cheese scones, four.
- 90. Madeira Cake, own recipe.
- 91. Chocolate Sponge Sandwich.
- 92. Rock Cakes, four, men only.
- 93. Mince Pies, six.
